Commission staff confirms that work paper SCE17HC054 Rev. 0 has interim approval. Upon non-exhaustive review, Commission staff finds information in the WP to not fully satisfy the requirements of the disposition released on 11/7/2016 for WPSCGREHC160624A-Rev00. Therefore, in the upcoming months, Commission staff will work with SCE and others to obtain the necessary data to support a detailed review of SCE17HC054 Rev. 0.

The outcome of any detailed prospective review shall become effective no earlier than 1/1/2018. Some of the required data is enumerated here. SCE shall coordinate with Commission staff and consultants for the full requirements. In the event that any data requested by Commission staff or consultants is withheld or continues to be found insufficient, SCE jeopardizes its ability to submit programs claims beyond 1/1/2018. Further guidance shall be provided from Commission staff at that time.

Examples of data required and/or areas where thoughtful elaboration is required:

1. Sales data
2. Detailed actions conducted by PA (or others) to ensure program eligibility requirements are met
3. Detailed analysis, methodology and, in particular, data used to support ex ante values proposed in workpapers
